James M Roshetko, ICRAF (World Agroforestry Centre), Indonesia

James M Roshetko is an Agroforestry Systems and Integrated Natural Resource Management Scientist with 37 years of experience, including 32 years working in Southeast and South Asia. The focus of his research has been to generate and apply science-based knowledge to enhance rural development options through improved sustainable environmental management.

Hwan-ok Ma, ITTO, Japan

Dr. Hwan-ok Ma is Officer-in-Charge, Division of Forest Management, International Tropical Timber Organization (ITTO), an intergovernmental organization based in Yokohama, Japan, that promotes conservation of tropical forest resources and their sustainable management. He is an expert in forest-based climate change mitigation adaptation and biodiversity conservation in production forests in tropical countries.

Suwan Tangmitcharoen, Royal Forest Department, Thailand

Dr. SuwanTangmitcharoen is an Expert on Forest Plantation Promotion at the Royal Forest Department. As a scientist he has over 32 years of experience and held several management positions including Head of the Forests and Climate Change Division, Ecosystem Services & Climate Change Division, Plantation Production Division, Environment, Biodiversity and Ecosystem Unit, and the Training & Consultancy Unit at the Forestry Research Institute of Ghana.

Markku Kanninen, University of Helsinki, Finland

Dr. Markku Kanninen was the Research Director and Professor Emeritus at the Department of Forest Sciences of the University of Helsinki, Finland. He is an expert in tropical forestry, climate change, forest ecology, and forest management. He has been involved in tropical forest research for about 40 years. He received the prestigious Nobel Peace Prize as a member of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) in 2007.
